

# Our Uniform

We are proud of our school uniform. We believe that a uniform looks smart, is practical and wears well and contributes to a feeling of belonging to the school 'family'.

## Years 1 – 6 Only

Our uniform consists of:

- Summer**
- White shirt with collar, short or long sleeves
  - Green and gold striped school tie (KS1 or KS2)
  - Dark green V neck sweatshirt or cardigan with logo
  - Dark grey short or long trousers (not leggings or lycra)
  - Dark grey pinafore dress or skirt (not lycra)
  - Green and white checked dress (any style)
  - Grey, black or white short socks or white long socks
  - Black shoes or sandals (low heeled, not court or high wedge)
  - Sturdy sandals in a dark colour eg blue/tan/brown are acceptable
  - "All cover" apron or (old) painting shirt for art and craft to be left at school in their pump bag
- Winter**
- White shirt with collar, short or long sleeves
  - Green and gold striped school tie (KS1 or KS2)
  - Dark green V neck sweatshirt or cardigan with logo
  - Dark grey short or long trousers (not leggings or lycra)
  - Dark grey pinafore dress, skirt or culottes (not lycra)
  - Grey, black or white short socks or grey or black tights or long socks
  - Black shoes (low heeled, not court or high wedge)
  - Black boots (sensible, flat) – an option in bad weather
  - "All cover" apron or (old) painting shirt for art and craft to be left at school in their pump bag.

**Optional** (for Outdoors ONLY) - Dark green zip-up fleece with logo

- P. E. Kit**
- Gold polo shirt with logo
  - Green shorts (football type – not lycra)
  - KS1 – trainers
  - KS2 - unbranded, mainly white-coloured trainers (Velcro fastening is acceptable for those children who are unable to tie their own laces)
  - Dark green or dark coloured tracksuit for outdoor PE
  - Optional** – Dark green skort (shorts and skirt combined)

- Accessories** No nail decoration or makeup

- Hair** All children, girls and boys, are requested to tie hair up where it is long enough to do so. This is for both health and safety reasons and to look smart and ready for school. Hair must be tied up in PE. In swimming we request that children wear a swimming cap or tie long hair up. Non regulation hairstyles are not part of school uniform and should not be worn. These include:

- Patterns cut into the hair
- Hair that is long in parts and very short elsewhere
- Hair that has been spiked up/Mohican
- Hair dyed, either wholly or partly, in a non-natural hair colour

- Jewellery** Earrings – from a health and safety viewpoint, we do not encourage any of our children to wear earrings. Those who do should wear a maximum of one pair of small, flat, gold or silver studs (not hoops). For P.E/Games, children should be able to remove the earrings themselves. Those children who are unable to do so, need to bring in micropore tape from home to cover their earrings during these activities. No rings or necklaces (unless requested to have special dispensation).

- Hats** Baseball cap / Legionnaires Hat / Beanie Hat
