

TOPIC SPRING

This term we have started with the topic 'Egyptians'. In this topic, we learn all about where the Egyptians fit into history, Pharaohs specifically Tutankhamun, what the afterlife means to the Egyptians and they explored who built the pyramids and why. The children have the opportunity to be involved in practical activities so they can immerse themselves into their learning.

After half term, our topic changed to 'Water, Water, Everywhere.' In this topic, children will learn about features of rivers, the three courses of a river and they will compare UK rivers to the River Nile. Additionally, they will learn the difference between solids, liquids and gases and then apply this knowledge to the water cycle. We will be visiting Bewdley Museum to learn more about rivers which we are all very excited about.
