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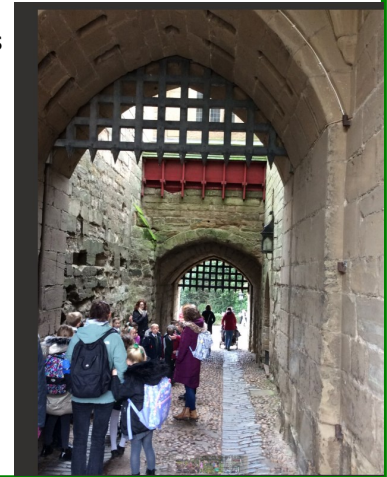
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### Year 2 Trip to Warwick Castle

## Eco-Committee Energy Saving Tips

At a recent meeting, the Eco-Committee discussed useful ways to save energy and support our environment. Energy saving tips our members put forward include:

- Turn the TV off when you're not watching it.
  - Turn the lights off when you're not there.
  - Use your washing machine at 30 degrees instead of higher temperatures.
  - Avoid overfilling the kettle.
  - Move your furniture away from radiators.
- Members also provided useful tips for water saving:
- Sing 'Happy Birthday' when you are washing your hands to keep them clean. Turn off the tap as you are singing.
  - Swap your bath for a shower and keep your shower time to four minutes using a timer to limit your water use.
