Pupil Premium

What is Pupil Premium and how could my child benefit?

Pupil Premium is additional funding that the Government gives to mainstream and special schools in England to help children who meet the criteria. The Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) must be spent to help eligible pupils reach their full potential, both academically and socially. Our school supports pupils with PPG in many different ways, including financial support for trips and residential visits, enrichment opportunities, targeted academic support, subsidised music lessons and uniform costs.

How much is the Pupil Premium Grant?

Schools will receive £1,480 for eligible primary-aged pupils qualifying for Free School Meals, £2,570 for each Looked After Child and pupils with a parent in the armed forces will receive £335.

The Pupil Premium is EXTRA GOVERNMENT MONEY which is paid to schools to SUPPORT children in reaching their potential. We, as a school, will ensure that you & child will benefit from this extra funding.

BUT WE CAN ONLY APPLY FOR THIS IF YOU CLAIM YOUR FREE SCHOOL MEALS THAT YOU ARE ALREADY ENTITLED TO - EVEN AFTER YEAR 2

If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, the school receives more funding to ENABLE US to enhance provision
